

Our Services

Pike County Home Health

In 1969, 21 years after the grand opening of our Public Health Department, Pike County Home Health Services were officially offered to our community. Home Health is care provided in a home or residence during a time of acute onset or worsening of a condition that requires a nurse or therapist (physical, occupational, or speech).

Pike County Hospice

In 1993 Pike County Hospice was established, and since then we have been caring for the terminally ill within our community with pride. Hospice is a specialized type of care for those facing a life-limiting illness, their families and their caregivers. This special care addresses the patient's physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs. It takes place in the patient's home or in a home-like setting and also assists the patient's family caregivers. Hospice care concentrates on managing a patient's pain and other symptoms so that the patient may live as comfortable as possible and make the most of the time that remains.
